NCT Group partners JK Medical Group in medical tourism deal

KUALA LUMPUR — Local property developer, NCT Group of Companies (NCT Group) inked a partnership with Korean wellness-centre operator JK Medical Group recently at the Ritz Carlton Hotel in Kuala Lumpur. The agreement involves JK Medical Group managing the wellness centre of NCT Group's premier serviced apartment, Ion Delemen located in Genting Highlands. It is a property spread across 10.2 acres of lush green land. It comprises six blocks of 1,001

resort-styled serviced apartments, ranging in size from 388 sq ft to 2,970 sq ft. As the only serviced apartments amid the hotels and resorts in the vicinity, the property has enjoyed tremendous response from investors and home-seekers alike. Phase 1 and 2 were completely sold since the initial launch in early 2014. Phase 3 is now available for sale. The "Tower 7" of Ion Delemen will comprise of 333 units, ranging in size from 338 to 988 sq feet.
