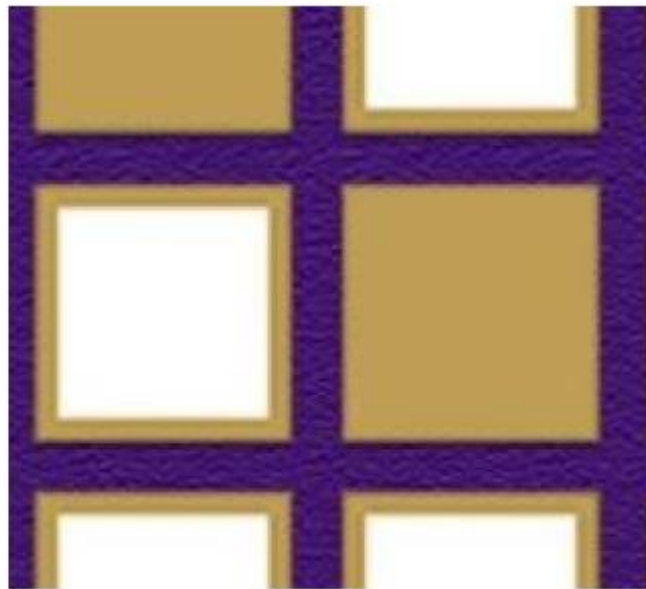

MELAKA 12 April. – NCT Group of Companies (NCT Group) telah mendaftar untuk 2,000 keahlian golf dengan Ayer Keroh Country Club Bhd (AKCCB) bagi membantu meningkatkan pembangunan pelancongan sukan di Melaka.
